



DESCRIPTION:

Knowledge of first aid which constitutes life saving treatments for injuries or unexpected illnesses is important for every individual at every age. Basic first aid training prepare students to react to situations and provide immediate efficient action for a wide variety of accidents. The ultimate goal of first aid is neither to treat nor diagnose but to stabilize the casualty. To create awareness among the students about this, First Aid awareness program was conducted by Mr.K.Pazhanivel, secretary of Indian red cross society on 4th and 5th of April 2024.

Starting from, procedure to react in accident spots, he taught the different first aid techniques that first aider should use in case of any accidents or emergencies. The followings are some the situations discussed - fire accidents, snake bite, dog bite, cardiac arrest, choking, seizures, electric shocks, drowning incidents and many more. Mainly he explained the procedure to perform CPR (cardiopulmonary resuscitation) with a mannequin and a video was also presented to show the do's and don'ts of CPR. He also cleared the myths about first aid like tying rope in case of snake bite, providing water to the casualty, applying ink or other liquids in case of burns. He even asked few students to perform CPR on the mannequin. A total of 424 students attended the awareness session. Overall the session was






