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

I was interviewed by Virtusa. Round 1: First, they conducted an online written test. In this round, we were asked some aptitude and technical questions and they were all related to concepts, DBMS, Java, software engineering and testing, hands-on-coding, etc. Round 2: In the technical HR round, started with tell me about yourself, some aptitude questions, why do you want to join software company being an ECE student and asked to do some hand-on-coding. Round 3: It was HR round, the interviewer asked some questions on core java, tell me about yourself and why do you want to join Virtusa. I practiced questions related to Verbal Ability, Quantitative Aptitude, and Logical Reasoning.

For technical, I focused on Object-Oriented Programming, Database Management of Networking basics System, programming language like C, Java and Python. I prepared myself with few of the most commonly asked HR questions like tell me about yourself, why you want to join us. Apart from this, I had two internship experiences that helped me largely to bag the job offer. Placement cell is a pillar of strength which provided complete support to achieve my career goals. 

Hello everyone! My name S.Gowtham. I'm currently pursuing a B.E. at Meenakshi Sundararajan Engineering College electronics domain in the of communication engineering. Recently, I got placed at Kaar Technologies in the role of Tech Sergeant (SAP). I would like to share my experience of the whole process. First of all, the whole selection process consists of 4 phases. Phase 1 is aptitude and consists of 45 questions. Regular aptitude classes conducted by our college actually helped me to solve the problems very easily, as the questions were lengthy and would require at least two minutes to read or understand thoroughly. Personally, Ι started to learn programming as it is essential for the selection process. Those who advance from round one are invited to the round of group discussions (8–10 per discussion). The round lasted roughly 45 minutes. The GD assessor believed that it was important to choose a subject on which everyone could agree to move the conversation ahead. "How Sports Contribute to Leadership Skills" was the subject. I did my best to stay on topic and make more persuasive arguments. Fluency is more crucial in order to win this round. Personal HR is the decisive round. For around 30 minutes, it consists of general conversation, questions about my resume, the company, willingness to shift locations, and my family background. In addition, the interviewer asked a number of questions related to the core subject. But the extensive training that our college placement cell provided enabled me to breeze through the interview.



To start off, the Placement team in our college for this academic year 2022 - 2023 has done an excellent job in providing placement offers for our students. I would like to show my gratitude to the student team and the Placement faculty for their never-ending efforts and attention to detail. The various tasks they performed were collaboration with various organizations, organizing various sessions to enlighten students on technical terminologies and various assessment tests for improving our aptitude skills. 
